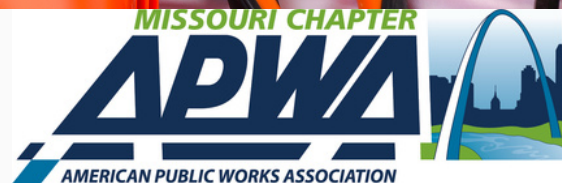

Spire has created a centralized email address for conflict review requests across the Missouri East service territory.

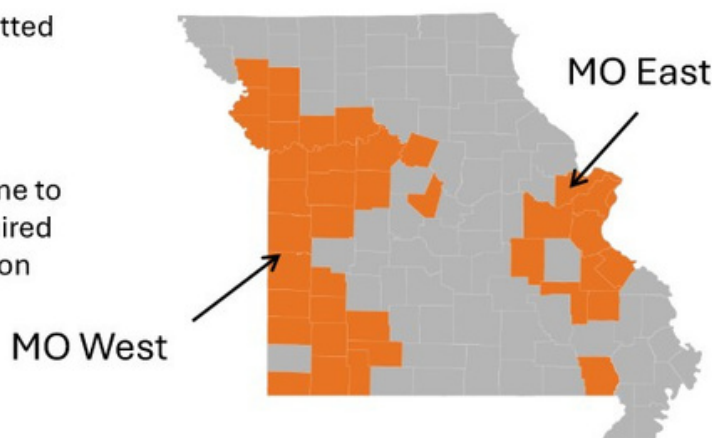
Submission Requests

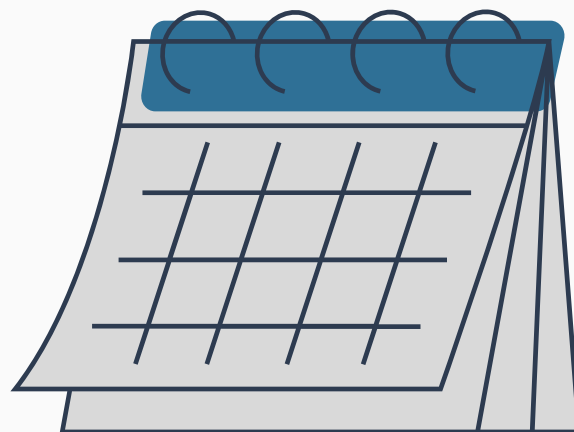

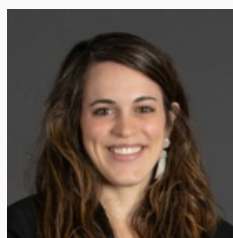
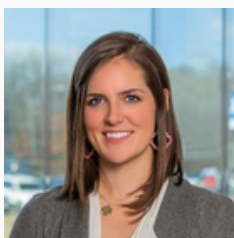
